I'm writing to inform you of *A Safe Place's* Supervised Visitation and Exchange Services for families separated due to domestic violence and how these services may assist some of your clients.

We believe parents have a shared responsibility for their children. Most often children benefit from having regular contact with both parents, regardless of the parents' relationship. Supervised Visitation and Exchange Services are designed around the child(ren)'s well-being and the need to have safe, positive contact with their non-custodial parent.


There are benefits to Supervised Visits and/or Exchanges for all family members:

- Child(ren) are able to maintain contact with both parents. They can anticipate visits without the anxiety of worrying about what is going to happen and enjoy their visits without being put in the middle of their parents' conflicts.
- The Custodial Parent can feel comfortable allowing their child(ren) to visit with the non-custodial parent, confident about the child(ren)'s safety. They do not have to communicate or have any contact with a person they are in conflict with, or who may frighten or intimidate them.
- The Non-Custodial Parent can have uninterrupted contact with their child(ren), regardless of problems or conflicts they may be having with the child(ren)'s caretaker(s). They can visit without fear of accusations as there is a monitor present who can verify what happened during the visit.

Our goal at *A Safe Place* is to work with both parents or guardians and the court system to make supervised visitations and exchanges accessible for everyone. Both parents are required to complete an on-site intake prior to any scheduled visits or exchanges. There is a \$25 fee for the intake session, but no further fees for visits or exchanges.
